Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSHE)

As a whole school, we are continuing to embed "An attitude of gratitude." we will be learning about ways to regulate our feelings and emotions this half term.

We will also be focussing on changes in preparation for transition.

Communication and Langauge

Our focus this half term is using sentences to talk about the past and using the correct grammatical tense when speaking. Our nursery children will engage in activities with adults on a daily basis and build language skills while exploring our learning environment through play.

🐔 Phonics and reading

Reception We are embedding all of our phonic knowledge and focussing on consonant blends.

Nursery are are continuing to explore a sound a week linked to a story. They will take part in short group activities linked to the sound and book. We do lots of singing and rhyme.



Maths

Reception will be focussing on adding, taking away, sharing and grouping. The children will also be embedding their knowledge of number bonds to 10.

Nursery enjoy short group time activities which include singing, games and counting and comparing objects. We will be practicing our measuring skills by exploring length height and capacity.



Literacy

We will start the term with Hairy Maclary by Linley Dodd . The children will set up and create labels for an Animal Shelter. Some cats and dogs will arrive and the children will help settle them in. The children will research facts about cats and write their own version on the story. The Second book is *Oi Frog by Kes Grey*. *We will* learn about rhymes and rhyming pairs. The children will also write about the life cycle of a Frog linked to our investigation.



Expressive Art and Design

Music: We are exploring big bands - we will learn how about instruments and how to play tuned and untuned instruments.

Art, design and technology: We will be practicing our mark-making skills using Get Squiggling. We will look at The Snail by Henri Matisse and focus on collage. The children will create their own version of the artists work.



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Understanding the World

We will be learning how to care for animals (including ourselves) and what we need to survive. We will investigate the life cycle of a frog and explore mini easts in our local environment.

The children are interested in how our school has changed so we will be inviting some grandparents in to talk about their experience when they were young.



Physical Development

On Monday, Mr Brotherhood will teach the reception children cricket skills. On Fridays, Mrs Chisman will explore Athletics ready for Sports day. Please send your child in wearing PE kit.

Woodland Wildlings

Every Monday afternoon we will head down to the woodland. Please send your child in wearing suitable outdoor clothing and footwear.
