Our Learning - Autumn 1

THEME: OUTSIDE INSIDE

We will be noticing changes in nature as we enter into Autumn, exploring the natural world around us and embedding the growth mindset approach to learning.

PHONICS

Reception will begin learning letter sounds starting with s, a, t, p, i, n. Nursery will explore early phonics including working on listening to sound patterns, rhythm and rhyme.

LITERACY

We will begin reading Where the Wild Things Are and then Bringing the Rain to Kapiti Plain.

MATHS

We will begin to explore the composition of numbers to 5 building on what we already know. We will sing, play games and explore in nature and while playing.

PSHE

We will be exploring New Beginnings and what it is like to belong to a group.

What's New

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will explore the changing seasons, look at different types of animals and where they live including safari animals. We will explore floating and sinking.

RE

We will learn about the Creation story in RE and what we would create in the world, linking it to our school values of honesty, kindess and respect.

EXPRESSING ART & DESIGN

We will be exploring materials to make boats, linked to our floating and sinking learning. We will be doing observational art with apples.

COMPUTING

We will be using computational thinking skills of problem solving, logic and decomposition to explore patterns.

PE - EVERY FRIDAY

Fundamental skills of movement including balancing, running, stopping and hopping. Please come in PE kit on Fridays.
