

Churchside Homework Expectations – Rowan Class Autumn 1

Maths

Children should complete tasks set on TTRockstars on a weekly basis to support their fluency of times tables. Children will continue to participate in weekly class competitions and earn certificates to recognise their achievements, effort and progress.

If children do not complete their TTRockstars minutes, they will be expected to complete this during lunchtime.



Each week, children will take home their arithmetic tests so that they can practice any questions they may find difficult.

Reading:

Reading should take place daily, ideally with an adult listener and children should record their reading daily in their home-school diary.

School reading books will be changed after an adult at school has checked your child's understanding of the text. Children will be asked to complete a short book review to ensure the book has been read.

Writing:

Any grammar work given should be completed in the exercise book provided. This will then follow the children throughout their school journey.

Spelling:

In Year 4, children are expected to practice their spellings on a weekly basis. Spelling lists or activities will be given to the children each week. Please ensure you check your child's book bag.

Homework will be handed out on Fridays and handed in the follow Friday.
