

MAPLE CLASS - AUTUMN ONE CREATION AND COSERVATION

For English this term we will be reading *The Journey Home* and *Dear Earth*. For these unit we will be creating persuasive writing pieces as well as making posters and short stories.

ENGLISH

For maths we are looking at place value and addition and subtraction. This includes forming numbers in different ways, working with number lines and adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers

MATHS

SCIENCE
