This week in Owls & Goslings, in Owls this week we have enjoyed learning about Marcus Rashford as part of Black history month. We were excited to learn that he was a famous footballer but also how he helped children by getting them food during Covid. As part of this learning we designed a healthy lunch box and enjoyed making our favourite sandwich.

This week in Skylarks, we had lots of fun during our SAW day on Monday. We explored an inquiry question 'how do animals in the arctic keep warm?' and tried insulating an ice cube with lots of different materials - even lard as blubber! (Don't worry, we wore gloves!). We also put brusho on an ice cube and observed how it made different colourful patterns when it melted to look a bit like the Northern lights. We made an arctic scene with our Northern lights and learnt how to draw polar bears too!

The children have completed some fantastic writing based on these books which have included adding detailed description using poetic devices such as similes. Join the Churchside Book Club!


Next half term we are going to introduce a fortnightly Lunchtime Book Club!


Key Stage One will be invited to read
