

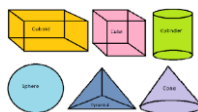
Autumn Term 2

English

We are starting the half term with the story “I want my hat back”. We will be writing a sequel to the story called “I want my friend back”. Children will be writing letters to ask for help and will be writing character descriptions for superheroes they create.

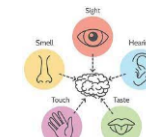
Maths

This half term we are focusing on addition and subtraction. Children will be learning number bonds within and to 10, as well as finding fact families. At the end of the half term, the children move on to looking at shape. They will be naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes.



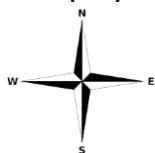
Science

In science this half term, we are learning about the human body. We will start by naming different body parts. We will use the book “Funnybones” to make and label skeleton pictures. We will then learn about our senses.



Geography

In Geography we are looking at maps. We will be looking at where we live in the UK and then focus on what a map of Mundford looks like. We will learn some map symbols before making our own maps.



Our theme this half term is “Heroes and Villains”.

This half term we are continuing our work on self-portraits. We will look at adding some shapes to our portraits so that they are in the style of Picasso.

Our enquiry question this half term is “How does a celebration bring a community together?” To answer this question we will compare how Christians celebrate Christmas with how Muslims celebrate Eid. We will end our learning by recreating both celebrations in the classroom.
