What have we been up to?

This week in Owls & Goslings, we enjoyed investigating melting and freezing on our SAW day. The children were given an ice cube and challenged to turn it from a solid to a liquid. They tried lots of different methods including wrapping them in fabric and placing them on the heater. For the art we loved cutting out symmetrical snowflakes and colouring them in cold colours.

This week in Skylarks, we made moon rocks and researched what the moon is like to investigate Imogen's question. We have built towers with 3D shapes to see which shapes make the best bases and what happens if we stack different shapes on top of each other. We thought cubes and cuboids made the best bases and triangular prisms were not good to balance on each other. We concluded that we couldn't balance things well on pointy shapes.

This week in Kestrels, we have been studying programming in Computing. We have used programmes such as Scratch and Crumbles to programme different algorithms. The children were brilliant at problem solving in order to get the hardware to follow their codes.




