## What have we been up to?

This week in Owls & Goslings, we started our new literacy tree book called 'Ning and the Night Spirits'. The children loved exploring what the night spirits might be and we enjoyed writing letters to Ning to advise him on how to make friends. We also explored the question, Would you rather live in a ginger bread house or a snow globe? This was in our P4C lesson. To support the children in their decision making we made ginger bread men and snow globes.

This week in Skylarks, we made egg box Nativity scenes as part of our RE question "How does a celebration bring a community together?" We thought about how people decorate their homes with a Nativity scene and the roles that each figure plays in the celebration of Christmas. We have also had a box delivered labelled fragile and have heard that there is an alien creature inside! Today we designed our own planet habitats for the creature thinking about what an animal needs to survive.

This week in Kestrels, we have had our No Plan Day and the children chose Pantomimes. We researched the history of pantomimes and then the children wrote their own pantomimes. We also learnt about how day and night occur and how the seasons happen. The children (and I) found it fascinating to find out about day, night and seasons on other planets, especially that winter lasts for 40 years on Neptune!


