Multiplication and Division


Length and Perimeter

Science

Our focus this half term will be **states of matter.**We will be grouping materials and exploring changing states of matter.



In addition to this, we will continue to develop our enquiry skills by carrying out fair tests, controlling variables and recording results in different ways.

Our theme this term is **Darkness and Light**

Music

In music this term, children will play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression.

Children will improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music. We will also continue to develop an understanding of the history of music.

PE

Art

In Year 4, children are expected to practice their spellings by completing activities sent home on a weekly basis.

Reading should take place daily, ideally with an adult listener. School reading books will be changed after an adult at school has checked your child's understanding of the text. Children should record their reading daily in their home-school diary.

Please encourage your child to access TTRockstars on a regular basis to support them with their fluency of times tables. This term, children will participate in weekly class competitions and earn certificates to recognise their achievements, effort and progress.
